Quilting 101

Required Book: START QUILTING WITH ALEX ANDERSON

Fabric needed: Fabric requirements will be discussed in the first class session. **Please do not purchase fabric prior to class.** We will also discuss other supplies that will be helpful to you in your quilting journey. **It is not necessary to bring your machine for the first class.**

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine in good working condition with power cord, foot control, slid on tray, with a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a Bernina. Extra machine needles (#80/12 Sharps).
- Rotary Cutter (45mm), Ruler (6"x24"), and cutting mat (18"x24" suggested)
- One yard of inexpensive muslin or other scrap fabric for use in practicing with your rotary cutter.
- 1/4" piecing foot for your machine, if you have one.
- Walking foot for your machine, if you have one.

Pre Class Preparation:

Please take the time prior to class to familiarize yourself with the basic functions of your sewing machine such as threading, winding a bobbin, adjusting needle position, varying stitch length, etc. You will find directions for all of these functions in your machine manual.



IMPORTANT!!!!

All classes have a class fee and/or book fee. All classes **MUST** be paid for at time of registration. Class registration will begin immediately upon receipt of this newsletter - by telephone with a credit card, by mail with check made out to Bernina Sewing and Design, or in the shop. **PRE-REGISTRATION** is preferred. Please register early to avoid the disappointment of the class being full or the class being canceled due to insufficient enrollment. Sewing machines and embroidery units must be in working order! **CANCELLATION and REFUND POLICY.** We make a commitment to our teachers one week prior to the start of each class.
