

# FIESTA de TALAVERA

The Fiesta de Talavera sampler is a collection of nine different applique blocks and an applique border. The designs were inspired by hand painted Mexican Talavera plates. This is my southwestern version of the classic Baltimore Album quilt.

The quilt measures 72" x 72" when complete. This quilt is for intermediate to advanced level quilters.

## YARDAGE REQUIREMENTS

	Complete quilt	Block #3 and border only
BACKGROUND	5 1/2 yards (includes yardage for binding)	1 1/4 yards (includes binding)
NAVY	2 1/8 yards	1/2 yard
LIME GREEN FAMILY	Scraps, Fat eighths or Fat quarters (4 - 6 assorted shades from light to dark)	SAME AS QUILT
YELLOW FAMILY	Scraps, Fat eighths or Fat quarters (4 - 6 assorted shades from light to dark)	8" x 10" MEDIUM YELLOW
HOT PINK FAMILY	Scraps, Fat eighths or Fat quarters (4 - 6 assorted shades from light to dark)	SAME AS QUILT
GREEN FAMILY	Scraps, Fat eighths or Fat quarters (4 - 6 assorted shades from light to dark)	6" X 9" MEDIUM GREEN
PURPLE FAMILY	Scraps, Fat eighths or Fat quarters (4 - 6 assorted shades from light to dark)	SCRAPS
ORANGE FAMILY	Scraps, Fat eighths or Fat quarters (4 - 6 assorted shades from light to dark)	SCRAP
TURQUOISE FAMILY	Scraps, Fat eighths or Fat quarters (4 - 6 assorted shades from light to dark)	8" X 10"-2 SHADES TURQUOISE
BLUE FAMILY	Scraps, Fat eighths or Fat quarters (4 - 6 assorted shades from light to dark)	N/A

## OTHER SUPPLIES NEEDED:

Basic sewing supplies (pencil, scissors, paper, pins, extra needles, etc.)

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler

Fusible webbing (My favorite fusible web is Heat N Bond Lite, but feel free to use your favorite.)

Fabric stabilizer (freezer paper)

Sewing machine with a zig zag stitch and a clear open toe foot (Bring all your machine attachments and manual to class)

Thread for appliqué (Your thread colors should match fabrics as close as possible.)

Thread for bobbin (I use a 60 wt thread in a color to match my background fabric.)
